You may be able to find more information about this and similar content on the piano.io (Pocket-lint) - Samsung has announced the Samsung Galaxy Note 4 as the long-awaited successor to the Galaxy Note 3. We put it head-to-head with the Galaxy S5, Samsung's flagship announced in April. Keep in mind we reviewed the Galaxy S5, but we haven't considered the Galaxy Note 4. While this guide guides you through differences in specifications and hardware in an attempt to see which one is really worth your money, the true real results have yet to be determined. So, what's better at the moment: The Samsung Galaxy Note 4 or the Samsung Galaxy S5? The Galaxy Note 4 features a 5.7-inch 2560 x 1440 Super AMOLED display with a 550ppi pixel density. The Galaxy S5 has a 5.1-inch Super AMOLED 1920 x 1080-pixel resolution and 430 ppi. This means that the Galaxy Note 4 has a larger display and a much higher pixel density. In real life, you won't notice a difference in density, but the difference in size is stark. Testing in the real world can even show differences in bright colors and black, although it's all very much down to personal preference. Screen villains will probably side with the Galaxy Note 4 on this one. Galaxy Note 4 is equipped with Qualcomm 805 2.7 GHz chipset or Exynos 1.9 GHz, as well as 3GB of RAM. Galaxy S5 has 2.5GHz quad-core Qualcomm Snapdragon 801 and 2GB. Just looking at the specs of the sheet, the Galaxy Note 4 has faster, more powerful technology, but again, testing may turn out differently. It's worth noting, however, the Galaxy Note 4 has the first 805 we've seen, and it's enough to make the device win this round at the moment. The Galaxy Note 4 features 32GB of built-in memory, with microSD card extensions, and we suspect it will deal with Dropbox with SGS5. The Galaxy S5 features 16GB and 32GB of on-board storage options, with microSD support for cards up to 128GB, and 50GB of free cloud storage via Dropbox for 2 years. There's little to call between them: the big difference here is that Samsung has stepped up its game by offering more basic storage for the Galaxy Note 4. The Galaxy Note 4 has a 3220mAh battery and energy saving mode, while the Galaxy S5 has a 2800mAh battery that will help you through the day. It also offers energy-saving features. Strictly looking at the specs, the Note 4 has a large battery and therefore wins this round. But it also has a bigger screen and a more muscular chipset that will weigh every heavily on the battery, so the Galaxy S5 can presumably win this round one day for its ability to last all day. We haven't seen what impact the display will have on battery life on the Galaxy Note 4. The Galaxy Note 4 has a 16MP rear camera (f/2.4 aperture) with optical image stabilization. It can also capture 4K Ultra HD videos. The front-facing camera is a 3.7MP (f/1.9 diaphragm) with a 90-degree wide angle by default, which goes up to 120 degrees for wide selfies. The Galaxy S5 is equipped with a 16MP sensor with a fast capture speed of 0.3 seconds. Like the Note 4, it can capture Ultra HD video. It also offers a number of intelligent features, such as selective focus. 2MP front-facing camera. Both are very capable, but the Galaxy Note 4 offers the best camera mounted on paper. With both offering Android 4.4 KitKat and TouchWiz, there's a lot that looks like the Galaxy Note 4 and SGS5 software experience. In some areas, these devices will be identical. However, despite the SGS5 offering some multi-proced options, the Galaxy Note 4 is a master here, using its huge display to great effect. One new feature minimizes open apps in a shortcut for easy access later. In addition, there is a range of S Pen features as well as hardware buttons to simplify daily performance tasks. These devices are designed for several different segments, but the Note 4 certainly provides when it comes to software settings. The Samsung Galaxy Note 4 doesn't differ too much from the Note 3, offering artificial skin back. It's nice and tenacious though, and despite being a great device, it fits well into your hands. It feels well built but still remains easy thanks to Samsung Plastics. The Galaxy S5 is also mostly plastic. It sticks to the usual design, but with a more tactile back for a better grip. The big positive thing is that it is dustproof and resistant in liquid up to a meter in (IP67 class) and it will be available in a variety of colors (shimmering white, charcoal black, copper gold and electric blue). There's not much to call between them. Much like we would like to see Samsung raise the Note to an absolute premium like the HTC One M8 that didn't happen. The Samsung Galaxy Note 4 goes bigger and better for almost everything compared to the Samsung Galaxy S5. This is a new device for a slightly different segment and is sure to retain its crown as the phablet of choice. The Note 4 has a higher-resolution display, but also a new chipset, the last of the Qualcomm if you're lucky enough to get an 805. With 3GB of RAM, it will almost certainly be snappier than the SGS5, but we can't say what impact these hardware changes will have on battery life. One thing we are sure of, however, is that the Note 4 will be well received. Written by Alice Yates. Here, Samsung Galaxy S5 for hunting kit. Okay, that's not exactly fair - camouflage, but one color you can get GS5 Active in - grey, red and green are other options - but how can you not go for camouflage, right? So we have here basically your standard Galaxy S5, hardened even for the IP67 original rating with some MIL-spec 810G thrown in in, basically, the rougher, tougher Galaxy S5. Physical differences are easy enough to discern. It's just a little taller and thicker. The smooth lines of the GS5 are broken down into what those of us who have seen too many sci-fi movies might call an exoskeleton. (But probably more accurate is just to say that there is some extra armor.) Like the Galaxy S4 Active, there are exposed rivets that always abplough me as sexy, in an industrial sense. Capacitive buttons have been sold for physical counterparts - the latest apps, home and back - and they have good clicks and textures for them. They are physical buttons - a bit of an anachronism to be sure, but remember that it is a durable phone. The capacitive buttons just won't cut it. The power button is in the usual place on the right side of the phone. There's a new volume button rocker, though. It's the Active Key. By default, a long push takes you to the camera app (and can serve as a shutter button if you want, but you'll have to include this in the settings). A short press version takes you to the Activity Area. It sounds like a fun kids hangout, but it actually brings up a screen with a barometer of readings - height and pressure in millibars - a compass (with GPS coordinates), and a one-touch flashlight button and stopwatch. You can re-map the active key on any number of other apps, however. Like the Galaxy S5 and GS4 Active in front of it, the USB port is hidden beneath what feels like a pretty rugged flap. Note that this is just a standard microUSB port though, rather than a new USB3 with its funky second connection. Hardly a deal breaker, in our opinion. Along the top bezel is a 3.5mm headphone jack, ir-port in case you have to channels in the wild), and a secondary microphone. While it's a durable-ish device, it still got a removable battery cover - with a removable plastic sticker warning you to put it back on the right if you want to keep the water and dirt out - and a removable 2800 mAh battery, the same power as the GS5 proper. (For what it costs, the batteries of both phones are the same size and shape and can be replaced, but they have different product numbers.) While we are at the back of the phone, it is worth noting that there are several protective plastic covers on the camera lens and flash/fingerprint sensor. (Again, in case you need to check your pulse in the bushes.) You're going to want to take them off. Software wise, we're looking at Android 4.4.2 with TouchWiz and a lot of bloat ATT. (To the surprise of absolutely no one.) We have a 16GB model here (which is all that is available) and about 10.9GB of memory available for us to use. There is still a microSD card slot under the battery door, however. Galaxy S5 Active manages to do it all without feeling like a tank, however. To be clear, there isn't much about it that it's a treat. It's a big, semi-wide phone. When you hold it, you don't worry about it. There's still a whole bunch of glass at the front, of course - that 5.1-inch display has quite a footprint, but it's also pretty fine in the full Florida sun - but at least there's a little lip to keep it off the bench you have to leave it face down. GS5 Active is currently available on ATT for \$199 under contract or \$714 immediately.
